Dear Families,

On Tuesday, April 20, 2021 the verdict for the murder of George Floyd was announced. When the news of former police officer, Derek Chauvin, found guilty of all accounts was announced they were varying reactions of excitement, sadness, anger, vindication etc. Many of us were not sure of what the outcome was going to be. My initial reaction was surprise and relief and then quickly I went back to my mindset of thinking about the work we must do as educators in name of justice. Unfortunately the murder of George Floyd is not a new occurrence...and continues to happen.

Northern Parkway School (NPS) is a place where topics such as this are discussed and shared on all grade levels. One of the things you will hear our teachers at NPS say is that we are here to let our children know that they have a voice (Jefferson-Isaac, 2021, Boardman, 2020, Vidal 2016).

We watched this trial, saw the witnesses give their testimonies and a jury make a decision. We want our scholars at NPS to be able use their voice and understand their power of choice as Darnella Frazier did with her use of a cell phone. This is the reason why this work of social justice is important to us at NPS.

We approach this work at NPS by building relationships with the scholars (Bodore-Woods, 2021, Boardman, 2020). *Morning Meeting* is a long standing practice at Northern Parkway (Jefferson-Issac, 2021, Responsive Classroom, 2016). Starting our school days with *Morning Meeting* in the classroom gives an opportunity to build community in a safe place. It is with trusting relationships and the connections made with children that allows us to approach difficult conversations.

Below you will find some resources that have been used in the classroom and that you could use at home. We invite you to share any resources that you come across or use when you are having important conversations with your families.

When we say Black Lives Matter at Northern Parkway School we say those words as an affirmation, as a healing call and an invitation to our whole school family to be in community with people of color locally and globally. We will continue to celebrate the Indigenous, African, Caribbean and Latinx cultures that connect us and embrace the beauty in this blending in our community


